

What is Travel Insurance?

Travel insurance provides financial protection against unexpected events that may occur during a trip.

Types of Travel Insurance



Trip Cancellation, Delay, & Interruption Insurance

TRIP CANCELLATION

If you or a family member falls ill or passes away and you're unable to take your trip, trip cancellation insurance can provide reimbursement for any pre-paid travel expenses.

TRIP DELAY

If your travel plans are disrupted due to a travel delay, such as a flight cancellation or delay, travel delay insurance will provide you with reimbursement for any pre-paid expenses.

TRIP INTERRUPTION

Reimburses you if your trip is cut short due to reasons such as: bad weather, airline strikes, terrorism, bankruptcy, jury duty, or damage to your home.



Medical & Accidental Death Insurance

EMERGENCY MEDICAL EXPENSE

In the event of an injury or illness while you travel, emergency medical expense coverage will provide reimbursement for any medical or emergency dental expenses.

MEDICAL EVACUATION

This coverage offers emergency transportation services to either a nearby hospital in your travel location or for transportation back to a hospital near your home.

ACCIDENTAL DEATH

This coverage is typically split into three parts: air flight accident, common carrier (public transportation), and accidental death. It provides coverage in the case of accidental death or dismemberment during your trip.
